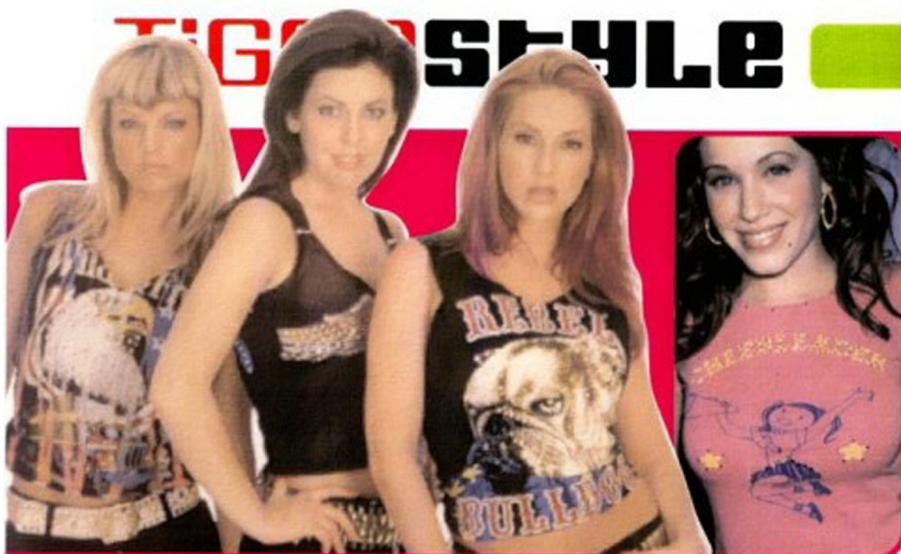

Turn your tees from blah to blazing in four easy steps!

To create some cool, studded fashions, we teamed up with Marianne Nowotny, whose new album *Manmade Girl* will be released this summer. When Marianne, 18, isn't writing and producing music, she makes trendy merchandise to sell at her shows. With the help of the Be-Dazzler, a handy and easy-to-use tool that secures studs and rhinestones to fabric, you can turn simple t-shirts into stage-worthy performance pieces.

### Make Your Own!



Once you have the item you want to stud, load a stud into the machine, which has different-sized applicators to fit different sizes of studs. The tool acts as a stapler, pushing the stud's prongs through the fabric and then securing them underneath.

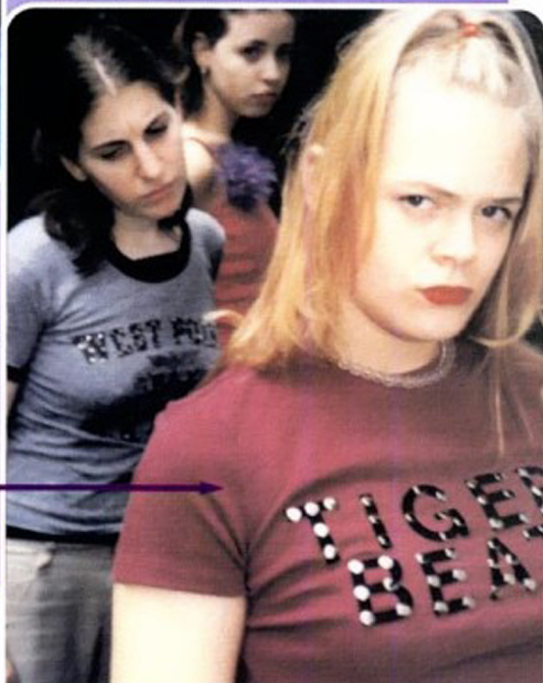


Draw your letters or design in chalk (which washes out) to mark where you want to fasten the studs. Make sure the letters are positioned how you want them. For smaller studs, you can also use a pencil to mark your spots.



Position the stud tool into the shirt like you would put a stapler under paper, making sure that only one layer of fabric is between the stud head and the base of the tool. Once the stud is lined up in the proper position, push down firmly.

4 Continue loading and studding until your creation is totally glam! ●
